COVID-19 Scams to Avoid

- 🧻 Don't respond to texts, emails or calls about checks from the government.
- 🧻 Ignore online offers for vaccinations. There are no products proven to treat or prevent COVID-19 at this time.
- 🧻 Be wary of ads for test kits. The FDA recently announced approval for one home test kit which requires a doctor's order. But most test kits being advertised have not been approved by the FDA and aren't necessarily accurate.
- 🧻 Hang up on robo calls. Scammers are using illegal robo calls to pitch everything from low-priced health insurance to work-at-home schemes.
- 🧻 Watch for emails claiming to be from the CDC or WHO.
- 🧻 Use sites like coronavirus.gov and usa.gov/coronavirus to get the latest information. And don't click on links from sources you don't know.
- 🧻 Do your homework when it comes to donations. Never donate in cash, by gift card, or by wiring money.
