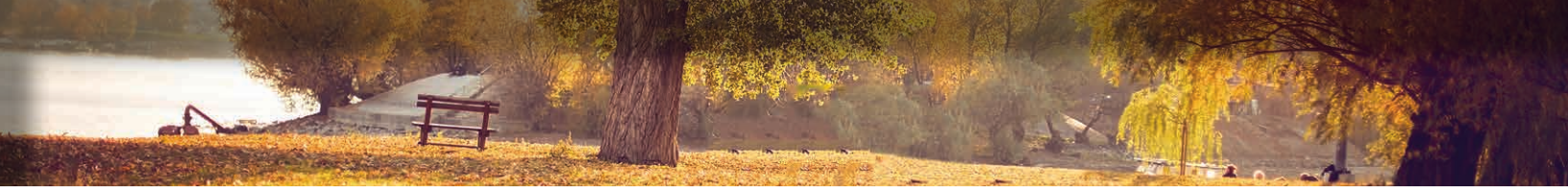

*One SAP per loan. SAP privileges are not guaranteed. \$25 fee for each loan skipped. Exclusions are: VISA, Mortgage Loans, Santa Loans, Back to School Loans, Credit Builder Loans, LTV Loans > 100% and any loan that has not had at least 6 payments made. Skip - A - Pay privileges are not guaranteed.

FRAUD TIPS DON'T BE A VICTIM!

TECH SUPPORT SCAMS - If a pop-up or error message appears on a website you visit and it has a phone number, DON'T call the number. These fake error messages aim to scare you into calling their "technical support hotline".



PHISHING EMAIL SCAMS - If you get an email that you are being charged for antivirus software, DON'T cancel the order or call them back.

PHONE SCAMS - DON'T answer unsolicited calls from people claiming to work for a government agency, free product trials, warranty expiring, etc. Ignore or Hang Up! If you call or answer the phone for these scams, YOU WILL GET CONNECTED TO A SCAMMER!

DON'T give personal or financial data or send money to people you don't know! If you are instructed to deposit cash at Bitcoin ATMs, buy gift cards, pay for service or send money back, IT'S A SCAM! When in doubt, contact us at 843.669.0461.
